#### **Salt Dome Roof Replacement**

### 1. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

- a. Successful vendor is responsible for complete removal and disposal of existing roof, flashings and insulation down to existing roof deck.
- b. All pipe flashings, plumbing pipe flashings will be removed and disposed of. All pipes penetrating the roof will receive new lead or galvanized flashings and be flashed per material manufacturer's warranty requirements.
- c. Reroof to be Malarkey the Alaskan Flexor SBS polymer modified 3-Tab shingles
- d. Underlayment to be Malarkey Arctic Seal self-adhering flexor SBS polymer modified underlayment
- e. Contractor to guarantee workmanship for a period of five years.
- f. Perform all work per Roof Material Manufacture's strict specifications and details so that finished roof system meets all requirements for material manufacturer's No Dollar Limit Warranty including all materials; including insulation, cover board, adhesives, roof membrane and flashing materials. Prior to start of work, contractor and representative from chosen membrane manufacturer will meet on site with Leavenworth County representative to review specifications and installation procedures.
- 2. <u>INVOICING</u>: The Contractor shall invoice no later than the third Monday of each month for the services performed during the previous month. Submit invoice to the Public Works Department, 300 Walnut Street Suite 007 Leavenworth, Kansas 66048 to the attention of Teresa Wilson.
- 3. <u>EMPLOYEES OF THE CONTRACTOR:</u> Employees of the Contractor assigned to perform this contract shall be subject to dismissal from the premises upon determination by the Deputy Director of Buildings and Grounds that such action is in the best interest of the County. - 7. <u>ANTI-DISCRIMINATION CLAUSE:</u> No respondent to this request shall in any way, directly or indirectly, discriminate against any person because of age, race, color, handicap, sex, national origin, or religious creed.
- 8. <u>INSURANCE</u>: The contractor shall be required to maintain and carry in force for the duration of the contract, insurance coverage of the type and minimum liability limits as set forth below:
  - a. *Professional Liability Insurance* \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and as an annual aggregate.

The contractor shall maintain the full limit of coverage as stated above for one year after substantial completion of any project resulting from this request for proposals.

This inclusion shall not make the County a partner or joint venture with the contractor in its operations hereunder.

The County Commission, County of Leavenworth, Kansas, its officers, commissions, agents and employees shall be named as additional insured as respects: liability arising out of acts performed by or on behalf of the contractor; projects and completed operations

of the contractor, premise owned, leased or used by the contractor; or automobiles, leased, hired or borrowed by the contractor.

In the event of an occurrence, it is further agreed that any insurance maintained by the County Commission, County of Leavenworth, Kansas, its officers, commissions, agents and employees shall apply in excess of and not contributed with insurance provided by policies named in this contract.

- 9. <u>IMMIGRATION LAW COMPLIANCE:</u> Leavenworth County is committed to employing only United States citizens or those who have valid permits to work in the United States.
